



House rules of the Kunsthalle Kiel

Welcome to the Kunsthalle in Kiel!

To satisfy the needs of visitors and their interests, and to guarantee the safety of the exhibits, certain rules must be observed. The house rules aim to make your visit to our museum as pleasant as possible and are binding for all guests. By entering the museum building, you accept the following house rules:

Opening hours

The Kunsthalle zu Kiel is open from Tuesday to Sunday and from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. On Wednesdays it is open from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. and on Mondays it is closed. For holidays or special occasions, there are possible arrangements that are displayed in the building and announced in the press.

Entrance fees

The admission fees can be found on the notice board at the box office. The following price categories apply:

a. Regular

b. Reduced. The reduced entrance fee applies upon presentation of the valid ID for:

- Schoolchildren, apprentices, students, FSJ, BuFD (over 18 years)
- Recipients of ALG I
- Severely disabled persons

c. Free admission after presentation of valid proof for:

- Children and adolescents under 18 years
- Groups of nursery children and school classes
- Accompanying persons of severely disabled persons
- Senior citizen's pass
- Kiel Pass and recipients of ALG II
- Students of Kiel University (CAU), University of Applied Sciences Kiel and Muthesius University of Fine Arts and Design
- Students of art history, art and other museum-related subjects
- Members of SHKV, DMB, ICOM, BBK, ADKV, etc.

Behaviour in the Kunsthalle

The Kunsthalle is responsible for the safety of the exhibits.

Therefore, it is prohibited:

- to touch exhibition objects or lean against works of art, pedestals and walls, unless expressly stated in writing.
- to take bulky items into the exhibition rooms.
- to bring animals into the house (except assistance or guide dogs).
- to eat or drink in the exhibition rooms and other public areas of the building (excluding the café and the entrance area).
- to smoke.
- to handle objects near the exhibits which are likely to cause damage to the exhibits.
- to use writing instruments other than pencils in the exhibition rooms. Walls and showcases may not be used as writing or drawing surfaces.

Cloakroom

For safety reasons, coats, jackets, capes, backpacks and large bags, photo cases, sticks, umbrellas etc. must be left at the cloakroom or in the lockers. Small bags (up to A4 in size) may be taken into the exhibition rooms. In case of doubt, the supervisory personnel will decide. Larger items of clothing cannot be carried over the arm. No liability is assumed for the cloakroom and valuables of any kind.

Liability

Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult to visit the art gallery. Teachers, group leaders and guardians are responsible for the appropriate behaviour of children and young people in their company. Guests are liable for all damages caused by their behaviour. The obligation to reimburse costs also applies in the event of intentional or negligent triggering of alarm systems.

Use of pushchairs/baby strollers

Visitors are permitted to bring a pushchair into the exhibition rooms if they ensure that they only use the pushchair to transport children. Children are permitted to push prams, and the supervisory staff are instructed to point out this rule to visitors. Bicycles, skateboards and scooters of all kinds are not allowed in the art gallery.

Photography and filming

Filming and photography are strictly for private use unless otherwise stated. The use of a tripod, flash or selfie stick is not permitted. Photography and filming for commercial and scientific purposes, as well as in the context of the press coverage, are allowed only with the consent of the Kunsthalle zu Kiel.

Supervisory staff/house rules

Visitors must follow the instructions of the supervisory staff. If the instructions of the supervisory staff are not followed, visitors may be prohibited from continuing their stay in the entire building. Through its representation, the management may exclude visitors from further visits to the Kunsthalle zu Kiel. This rule applies to those who do not comply with the house rules or the instructions of the supervisory staff, or those who otherwise distract or attempt to distract others through offensive conduct.

Suggestions and complaints

If you have any suggestions or complaints, please contact the supervisory or cashier staff, who will be happy to inform you about contact persons. We draw your attention to the video surveillance in all exhibition rooms, the foyer and the courtyard.
